Stands And Turning Points

CHESSINGTON, WORLD OF ADVENTURES

Private stand on west side of Leatherhead Road adjacent to Chessington (World of Adventures) car park.

Buses proceed from Chessington World Of Adventures Car Park direct to stand, departing to Chessington World Of Adventures Car Park. Set down in Chessington World Of Adventures Car Park, at Stop Z and pick up in Chessington World Of Adventures Car Park, at Stop Z.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: None
MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY: Chessington.

CHESSINGTON, COPT GILDERS ESTATE (From Kingston, Cromwell Road Bus Station)

Public stand for one bus on east side of Gilders Road, between Filby Road and Billockby Close on roundabout.

Buses proceed from Gilders Road direct to stand, departing to Gilders Road. Set down in Gilders Road and pick up in Gilders Road.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY: Copt Gilders.

HOOK, BRIDGE ROAD (from Kingston, Cromwell Road Bus Station)

Buses proceed from Hook Road via Bridge Road Roundabout departing to Hook Road. Set down in Hook Road, at Stop Q and pick up in Hook Road, at Stop P.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: **Turning Point Only - Buses must not stand**
DISPLAY: Hook, Bridge Road.

HOOK JUNCTION (from Kingston, Cromwell Road Bus Station)

Buses proceed from Hook Road via Ace Of Spades Roundabout departing to Hook Road. Set down in Hook Road, at Stop HC and pick up in Hook Road, at Stop HP.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: **Turning Point Only - Buses must not stand**
DISPLAY: Hook Junction.

SURBITON, CLAREMONT ROAD (WEST SIDE) (from Chessington, World of Adventures)

Public stand on west side of Claremont Road, commencing 45.7 metres north of northern arm of The Crescent.

Buses proceed from Claremont Road direct to stand, departing via Claremont Road, Maple Road and Surbiton Road to Surbiton Crescent. Set down in Claremont Road, at Stop ND and pick up in Surbiton Crescent, at Stop B.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: Unscheduled curtailments only
MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY: Surbiton.

SURBITON, CLAREMONT ROAD (from Kingston, Cromwell Road Bus Station)

Buses proceed from Claremont Road via Victoria Road departing to Claremont Road. Set down in Claremont Road, at Stop NH and pick up in Claremont Road, at Stop NC.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: **Turning Point Only - Buses must not stand**
DISPLAY: Surbiton.

KINGSTON, CROMWELL ROAD BUS STATION

Private stand for 12 buses in marked bays in Cromwell Road Bus Station on north side of Cromwell Road. Buses to stand as follows:

Bays A5/A6 - Route 285,
Bays A7/A8 - Route 111,
Bay A9 - Route 216,
Bay A10 - Route 411,
Bay A11 - other operators,
Bay A12 - Route 481 and other operators,
Bays A13/A14 - Route K1,
Bays A15/A16 - Route 71.

Buses proceed from Cromwell Road via Cromwell Road Bus Station to stand, departing to Cromwell Road Bus Station. Set down in Cromwell Road, at Stop A2 and pick up in Cromwell Road Bus Station, at Stop A15/A16.

Garage Journeys

From Fulwell Garage to Kingston, Cromwell Road Bus Station:

From garage via Wellington Road, South Road, Stanley Road, Broad Street, The Causeway, Park Road, Sandy Lane, Park Road, Church Grove, Hampton Court Road, Kingston Bridge, Horsefair, Wood Street, Kingsgate Road, Sopwith Road, Richmond Road, Cromwell Road and bus station to line of route.

From Kingston, Cromwell Road Bus Station to Fulwell Garage:

From line of route via Cromwell Road (contra flow Bus Lane), Wood Street, Horsefair, Kingston Bridge, Hampton Court Road, Church Grove, Park Road, Sandy Lane, Park Road, The Causeway, Broad Street, Stanley Road, South Road and Wellington Road to garage.

From Fulwell Garage to Chessington, World of Adventures:

From garage via Wellington Road, High Street, Church Street, Hampton Court Road, Hampton Court Bridge, Hampton Court Way, Kingston By-pass, Kingston By-pass (slip road), Hook Road and Leatherhead Road to line of route.

From Chessington, World of Adventures to Fulwell Garage:

From line of route via Leatherhead Road, Hook Road, Kingston By-pass (slip road), Kingston By-pass, Hampton Court Way, Hampton Court Bridge, Hampton Court Road, Church Street, High Street and Wellington Road to garage.

Authorised Vehicle Types:
